### INTROAUCION:

We are pleased to provide an update on the Makwete Clinic construction project, funded by Medical Mission News and implemented by the local community of Kambali village, with oversight from Seed Sowers Trust.

### Project Update:

Initial plans to locate the clinic at Makwete were revised following consultation with the Ministry of Health, which advised relocating to a centralized location to serve three surrounding villages: Kambali, Magagada, and Muluntha.

The new location will enable the clinic to serve a population of approximately 2,500 people, including 364 children under the age of 5, according to data from the Health Surveillance Assistant.

- The clinic will offer essential services, including:
- Immunization of infants
- Health education
- Nutritional assessment
- Family planning
- Other vital health services

**Construction Progress:**

- Site preparation and excavation works are complete
- Foundation works are in progress
- The project is expected to be completed within the next 6 months

**Community Engagement:**

- The local community has been actively involved in the project through volunteer labor and material contributions
- The project has fostered a sense of ownership and responsibility among community members

**Challenges and Lessons Learned:**

- The project faced delays due to the relocation, but this has ultimately resulted in a more strategic and effective location
- The importance of community engagement and participation in project planning and implementation has been reinforced
